Academy regular training equipment e.g. gloves etc. cannot be loaned out to ensure safety.</li> <li>On entering the building Students (and parent only if necessary) to enter the clearly marked one-way system and move one at a time.</li> <li>Each student will be supervised by a staff member while using the hand sanistiser station, having a temperature check and their attendance being confirmed. The touch screen will not be in use for hygiene reasons.</li> <li>Each student will place their shoes and any bags in a designated area before being invited to their allocated training area via the one-way system.</li> <li>Stairs/Viewing area (mezzanine) to be closed except for very exceptional circumstances.</li> </ul>	1
