Staying COVID – 19 Secure

The safety of our visitors and exhibitors is Appletree Exhibitions priority. We can confirm we have complied with the Government's guidance on managing the risk of COVID-19. We are working with the venue and following Government guidelines to ensure safety on site.

COVID-19 guidance is constantly being reviewed and Appletree Exhibitions will look to follow the relevant guidance at the time, on site.

We have implemented a number of steps to keep our customers and exhibitors safe in-line with Government guidance including:

CDS (Crowd Density Standard)

Appletree Exhibitions will allow for the Crowd Density Standard in accordance with government guidance. By controlling the density, appropriate social distancing will occur by the consideration of both the number of people and potential pinch points to determine the number of people in that area.

Pre-registration

Registration is required to enter site and all visitors have been advised to pre-register their attendance. This will help to minimise queuing, and to enable contact tracing to be carried out.

Contact tracing

Appletree Exhibitions will offer assistance to the proper authorities in contact tracing efforts in accordance with the current regulations by ensuring everyone on site has pre-registered. Anyone who has not pre-registered will be asked for their contact details on arrival.

Floor planning

Event walkways will be wider to allow visitors to be able to social distance effectively.

1m+ social distancing guidance.

Aisle widths will be increased.

Exhibitors will be given extra space on their stands to allow social distancing while on their stand. There will also be additional space given in between individual stands.

Viewing Vehicles

Please come prepared. When viewing vehicles, you must wear a face covering and sanitize hands before entering.

Food & Beverage on-site

Appletree Exhibitions along with their catering partners will look to provide a take away food service which may be ordered using an App. More information regarding this will be available at the show. Seating areas may be required to be removed or will be arranged to follow the CDS. If seating is available, then regular sanitising will take place.

Queueing

Appletree Exhibitions will ensure that any queuing areas are clearly marked with relevant social distancing signage and markers. A distance of 2m will be recommended for queueing areas as per current Government guidelines.

Enhanced cleaning regime

An enhanced cleaning regime of toilets will be conducted on-site. Cleaners will be directed to have an increased focus on key touch points, including restrooms and food and beverage areas. There will be a limitation on the number of people at any onetime using the toilet areas and this will be monitored. Social distancing signage and markers will also be on display.

Hand sanitiser stations

Hand sanitiser stations will be positioned at key locations throughout the event, including main entrance, restrooms and food and beverage locations. Signage will also be displayed around site to encourage all on-site visitors to do this regularly.

Event Signage

Signage will be displayed prominently, in common areas, around site and this together with public addresses (where available) will repeat messages about the importance of maintaining physical distance and the importance of washing and sanitising hands in addition to other best practices.

Wild camping

There will be limited pitches available on-site.

These must be pre-booked.

They will be marked out so as to leave a pitch in between each.

We encourage you to use your own facilities. There will be limited toilets on-site and these will be closed during the night.

Elsan tipping points will be available as will water taps.
